



Dear Fisherman,

Thank you for purchasing **WINCO'S Hand Poured Softbaits**.

The following information & tips may help you hook and land more bass:

- 1- Scent, salt, and sand are mixed into the plastic before pouring. Neither product will wash off with repeated use. No additional added scent is recommended.
- 2- Rig all stick worms along the seem to ensure the fully-rounded worm hangs and falls horizontally. The worm will "shimmy" from side to side with that enticing "tail-wiggle" on the drop. All other worms should be rigged flat side down. The bait will dart and fall properly when hooked in this manner. Most fish will be hooked in the roof of the mouth.
- 3- **Gamakatsu EWG** hooks are recommended for use when rigging all **WINCO'S Hand Poured Softbaits** except "Wacky" worms (see #5). Slightly skin-hook the point of the hook into the top of the bait when fishing in wood and/or weeds.
- 4- **WINCO'S Hand Poured Softbaits** sink without any additional weight being added. However when "Texas-worm" fishing in depths greater than 6 feet, adding weights of 1/8 -1/4 ounce will be helpful, especially when trying to feel bottom structure.
- 5- All "Wacky" worms come with a tight band or an (o) ring around the center of the worm. Rig the hook through the center of the worm, under the band, and exposed on the other side. **Gamakatsu octopus circle** or the new **Finesse wide gap** hooks are recommended. A piece of plastic worm over the hook point will make this rig 90% weedless and give you the ability to finesse the rig through trees. The use of a 1/16 ounce WATER GREMLIN "bull-shot" 6 inches below the wacky worm will enhance the wacky-action and produce a quicker decent.
- 6- We strongly recommend the use of PRO's SoftBait Glue® (Caution !!! This product has the consistency of water, "do not" squeeze the container when applying). Rig your hook into your softbait with the line attached as you normally would. Hold the line about 3" above the softbait and apply one drop of glue where the line enters the lure (wait 15 seconds). This product can also secure plastic trailers on spinnerbaits, buzzbaits, and jigs. This product can successfully repair most of your split or torn plastic softbaits.
- 7- The products displayed on this website have been successfully tested on the following bodies of water: 1000 Islands, Beltzville Lake, Carnegie Lake, Delaware River (tidal and non-tidal), Hudson River, Lake Ontario, Lake Wallenpaupack, Manasquan Reservoir, Marsh Creek Lake, Mercer Lake, Merrill Creek Reservoir, Neshaminy Creek, Nockamixon Lake, Penn Warner Club Lakes, Perkiomen Creek, Schuylkill River, Shohola Lake, Spruce Run Reservoir and Susquehanna River.
